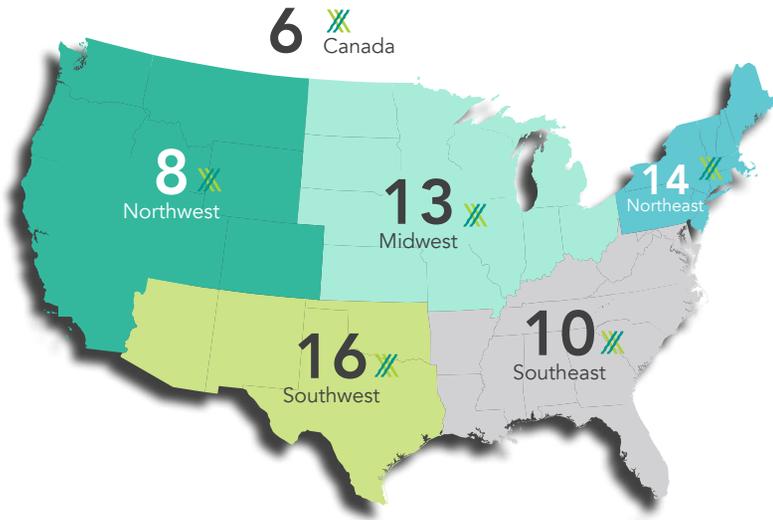

Our Work & Programs

PEER LEARNING CIRCLES

We work primarily through learning groups focused on priority topics such as Equity, Design, Funding & Financing, Performance, Planning & Resilience, and Asset Management. These groups are forums where peers share information, experiment, and work together to create better GSI solutions faster.



COLLABORATIVE GRANT PROGRAM

Our Collaborative Grant Program provides Exchange members with the opportunity to work with one another and their community partners on projects that improve the speed, cost, or effectiveness of local GSI programs. Each year, the Exchange funds 3-5 projects, the products of which become components of our GSI Library.



ANNUAL MEETING

Each year, we host a network-wide gathering where members exchange resources and knowledge, make new connections, build relationships, and take part in network decision-making. Members contribute input and feedback about all elements of the program’s design and planning, as well as generate the majority of the content.
